An emergency or urgent public necessity exists only if immediate action is required because of: (1) an imminent threat to public health and safety; or (2) a reasonably unforeseeable situation. See Tex. Government Code §551.045(b). There exists an urgent public necessity involving health and safety of the citizens and employees of Reno, Texas regarding the National Declaration of a Health Disaster by the President of the United States regarding the "Corona" virus; and the corresponding need, consistent with the recommendation of the Center for Disease Control for managing the virus by social distancing and reducing public crowds.
