MINUTES

- I. Call to Order. Council member Stacey Nichols called meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.
- II. Roll Call. Absent: Mayor Bart Jetton, and Council member James Dority. Council members present: Amanda Willows, Stacey Nichols, Brandon Thomas. Also present: Mayor Pro Tem Joey McCarthy and City Secretary Tricia Smith taping the minutes.
- III. Discussion/take action on:
- a. Canvass returns from City Council Election of May 7, 2022. Stacey Nichols read the results of the canvass as follows:

Consistent with Texas Election Code Section 2.002, a tie vote in any election can be resolved as follows:

- 1) Cast a lot
- 2) Agreement by one candidate to withdraw
- 3) Run Off Election

David Ervin withdrew from the May 7, 2022 Reno General Election on May 9, 2022.

As a result of this withdraw Ryan Skidmore is elected to the third Council seat, joining Brandon Thomas and Joey McCarthy as candidates with the most votes.

This officially makes canvassing the 2022 Reno General Election complete.

Council member Thomas moved, with a second from Council member Willows, to accept the canvass returns as presented. Motion carried 4-0.
