- I. Call to Order. Mayor Nichols called meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.
- II. Roll call. Council members absent: Bill Ruthart. Council members present: Amanda Willows, Ryan Skidmore and Brandon Thomas. Also present: Mayor Stacey Nichols, Mayor Pro Tem Joey McCarthy and City Secretary Tricia Smith taping the minutes.
- III. **“BUDGET WORKSHOP”** – Council to discuss budget for the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and tax rate for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. Council discussed the tax rate and budget.
- IV. Business-Discuss/Take action on:
 - a. Adoption of Ordinance No. 341, making appropriations for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year Budget. Council member Thomas moved, with a second from Council member Skidmore, to adopt Ordinance No. 341, making appropriations for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year Budget. Motion carried 4-0.
 - b. Approve property tax rate for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year. Mayor Pro Tem McCarthy moved, with a second from Council member Thomas, that the property taxes be increases by the adoption of a tax rate of .461, of that .3860 percent is for M&O and .0750 percent is for I&S. Motion carried 4-0.
 - c. Ratify the property tax revenue increase reflected in the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year Budget. Mayor Pro Tem McCarthy moved, with a second from Council member Skidmore, to ratify the property tax revenue increase reflected in the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year Budget. Motion carried 4-0.
 - d. Adoption of Ordinance No. 443, levying ad valorem taxes for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year. Mayor Pro Tem McCarthy moved, with a second from Council member Willows, to adopt Ordinance No. 443, levying ad valorem taxes for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year. Motion carried 4-0.

- g. Deliberations regarding real property. Council entered into executive session at 5:49 P.M. Council returned to open session at 6:07 P.M. No action taken.
