MINUTES

- I. Call to Order. Mayor Jetton called meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.
- II. Roll Call. Council members present: Tom Brandenburgh, Amanda Willows, Brandon Thomas and Joey McCarthy. Also present Mayor Bart Jetton, Mayor Pro tem Rick Jordan, City Attorney David Hamilton and City Secretary Cara Hubbard taping the minutes.
- III. **“PUBLIC HEARING”**- Discuss/take action on a Zoning Variance and adoption of Ordinance No. 2015-7-13 granting a variance to Chapter 14, section 6.002 of the Planning and Zoning regulations, permitting a recycle and retail salvage operation as a variance to the “Use Regulation” of said Ordinance, providing for exclusive application of the variance; and providing a severability clause and effective date. Public hearing opened at 6:02 P.M. Ben Glick with Recyclers Depot addressed Council requesting variance. Citizens that spoke for the variance: Chris Gunn 6920 Lamar Road and Chey Thomas 235 Mt. Olive Road. Citizens present to speak against the variance: Jack Nelson 6960 Pine Mill Road, Paul Payne 6980 Lamar Road and Sean Huffman 120 Sandy Lane. Public Hearing closed at 6:30 P.M. Council member McCarthy moved, with a second from Council member Thomas, to approve zoning variance and adoption of Ordinance No. 2015-7-13 granting a variance to Chapter 14, section 6.002 of the Planning and Zoning regulations, permitting a recycle and retail salvage operation as a variance to the “Use Regulation” of said Ordinance, providing for exclusive application of the variance; and providing a severability clause and effective date.
